



## Instructions: Cactus



STEP 1

Place the growing medium pellets in a bowl. Add 2-1/4 cups lukewarm water. The pellet will expand as it absorbs the water and turn into growing medium. Fluff the growing medium with a fork, adding more water if necessary.



STEP 2

Add growing medium to the container.



STEP 3

Sprinkle seeds over growing medium and lightly press seeds into the growing medium.



STEP 4

Cover pot with plastic wrap. Secure with rubber band if necessary.

## Care:



WATERING

Keep moist, but do not overwater. Pull back plastic wrap and lightly mist with a spray bottle as necessary. Replace plastic wrap.



LIGHT

Place pot in a warm, sunny location. Avoid direct sunlight until after seedlings are well established (3-6 months after seedlings emerge). For best results, rotate the pot often so all sides receive equal sunlight.



GERMINATION

Germination may take 1 to 3 months. Remove plastic wrap to spray mist and keep growing medium moist as necessary. Replace plastic wrap after misting.

TRANSPLANTING

Once seedlings emerge, poke a few holes in the plastic wrap for air circulation. Remove plastic wrap once seedlings are about the size of a pencil eraser (3-6 months after seedlings emerge). Continue to mist growing medium allowing growing medium to dry out between mistings. Keep in mind that cactus plants grow very slowly.
